Subject:- Grant of Yearly Permission to Smt. Shantadevi Memorial Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Badagandi, Tq. Bilagi, Dist Bagalkot-587116, Karnataka (Inst. ID- AYU0800) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27 and relevant regulation thereunder -reg.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Smt. Shantadevi Memorial Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Badagandi, Tq. Bilagi, Dist Bagalkot-587116, Karnataka (Inst. ID- AYU0800)** inspection was conducted on **25.05.2026 and 26.05.2026 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the **Permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.**
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the "Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report, visitor observation and approved punitive policy, it is found that your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria due to the various shortcomings.**
- 3) In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the **167th Board Meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on **30.07.2026**. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above, **the Board discussed and decided to provide an opportunity of virtual hearing** vide the MARB-ISM letter (Hearing notice) of **even number dated 31.07.2026** to appear before the designated Hearing Committee on **04.08.2026**, to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the Permission to your college with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course be reassessed as per Punitive policy.**
- 4) The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof to substantiate the claims against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide letter no.- SSMAMCH/678/2026-27 dated 02.08.2026** against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives, **Dr. Rajeshwari Biradar, Principal** of College appeared before the hearing committee on 03.08.2026 and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college.
- 5) Thereafter, the observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing was duly placed in the **170th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on **11.08.2026** and Board concluded that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of extended permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulation.
- 6) Hence, the Board decided to issue **Yearly Permission** in accordance with Regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) Course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic year 2026-27.

"DECISION"

- 7) Therefore, **Yearly Permission** in accordance with Regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and is hereby granted to Smt. Shantadevi Memorial Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Badagandi, Tq. Bilagi, Dist Bagalkot-587116, Karnataka (Inst. ID- AYU0800) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2026-27, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following conditions shall be fulfilled :-

- I. **Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats** shall be treated as all India quota. The counselling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2026-27 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counselling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- 8) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 9) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 10) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 11) **Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. Ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
- 12) It is also noted that, if the concerned University does not grant affiliation to the college or withdraws the affiliation, the permission granted by MARBISM shall automatically stand withdrawn without any further notice or order in this regard.
- 13) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2026 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2027-2028:-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- 14) The fulfilment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2027-28.
